## Message from the Executive Director

Over the past few weeks we have met with Government weekly and discussed many items. One of the most operational and important issues was access to PPEs and fit testing masks as we get them. We did seem to make great head way however Government's mind has changed and now they tell us that they will Fit Test those on the Emergency Center list released on May 7th. We have contacted those centers and shared the process of getting an appointment. We will be open on the 8th and then there will be no Emerg Centers so I don't know how they will deal with that.

It is absolutely atrocious and appalling that at a time when we all should pull together for the betterment of Public and society that Government decides that it is ok and proper to not help the Dental Community. Why I don't know. They I am sure can tell us that it is because of a lack of one thing or a need to protect something or their focus on something else. As we know that they have the testers and therefore can do the job we see it as a case of not willing and that is the sad part. The CMO and the Minister talk about flattening the curve and we

are all in this together.
