Changing how you receive and access the NSDA Dispatch

We are changing Dispatch to a designated webpage on the NSDA website instead of a newsletter-style email. The benefits will be:

- It will be easy to find (no more searching through emails).
- Sectioned into 'Latest News' and 'Previous News' for easy reading.
- Mobile-friendly. It will be a lot easier to read the information on mobile devices.
- Event Alerts, including a countdown to important events.

- Resources will be linked via the website and so they can be found in one place.
- You can return to the page at any time to review.

You will still receive an email informing you of current updated news on the Dispatch page plus a link to access it quickly. You can then simply return to the page to review.
