1. Commission on Dental Accreditation of Canada (CDAC) Meetings

The 2007 meetings of the Commission on Dental Accreditation of Canada were held from November 16-19, 2007 in Ottawa, Ontario.

2. Report of the Documentation Committee

The CDAC approved revisions to the Dental Specialties, Dental Hygiene and Dental Assisting accreditation requirements, effective January 1, 2008. The accreditation requirements are available on the web site: www.cda-adc.ca.

The Documentation Committee is establishing a Sub-Committee to identify revisions to the dental specialty accreditation requirements to permit the CDAC to assess dental specialty programs who have admitted internationally-trained dental specialists.

3. Report of the Finance Committee

American Dental Association Commission on Dental Accreditation (CODA)

The report from the American Dental Association Commission on Dental Accreditation (CODA) addressed the inclusion of Qualifying Programs within the CDAC/CODA Reciprocal Agreement, effective March 1, 2007, and International Consultation and Evaluation by CODA.

CODA continues to provide international consultation and evaluation to international DDS/DMD educational programs. This accreditation process applied to these programs would parallel the accreditation process in place to assess American DDS/DMD programs.

ADA has established a task force to study the CODA and a preliminary report will be available in summer 2008.

9. CDAC representation on ADA Site Visit - Reports

The reciprocal agreement between the Commission on Dental Accreditation (CDAC) of Canada and CODA is monitored through a process that permits both Commissions to annually participate on each other's site visits. The CDAC participated on one site visit in the United States in 2007, at Marquette University.
