

CADR-IMHA Student Research Awards

The Canadian Association for Dental Research (CADR) – Institute of Musculoskeletal Health and Arthritis (IMHA) Student Research Awards were presented at the International and American Associations for Dental Research meetings held in New Orleans, Louisiana, in March. The award winners were selected among trainees working in dental and oral health research in Canada.

Ms. Maryam Fathimani, a dental student at the University of Toronto (U of T), was awarded first place in the “Junior” category, while Mr. Corey Felix, a dental student at Dalhousie University, came second in the same category.

Dr. Limor Avivi-Arber from U of T took top prize in the “Senior – Basic Science” category, with second place awarded to Mr. Andrew Guzi, a graduate student at the University of Western Ontario.


