## Notice of claims processor change



Starting October 24, 2020, Canada Life will accept file attachments (patient records) for electronically submitted claims and predeterminations.

To streamline the claim submission process, securely send patient records using the CDAnet Attachment transaction. This will improve turnaround time and may reduce postage and administrative expenses normally associated with mailing these documents.

You can take advantage of this opportunity by using your practice management software to transmit patient records such as x-rays and images along with the claim or predetermination. You may also transmit them later if Canada Life requests them. Talk to your software vendor to see what options are available to you.

## Action required

On or shortly after Oct. 24, 2020, change the settings in your practice management software for Canada Life to enable the Attachment transaction.

## Change details

Canada Life must be set up in your software as CDAnet version 4, TELUS Group B.

- Request for Outstanding Transaction (04)
